

AGM 2023

A very successful Annual General Meeting was conducted by the HOG Namibia members on November 4, 2023 in Swakopmund. Including the proxies, the attendance was well over 80%, reflecting the continued interest of the members in the well-being of the Chapter.

- ⇒ National membership dues for Full Member to be increased to N\$ 600 per annum
- ⇒ National membership dues for Associate Member increased to N\$ 300 per annum
- Extra-ordinary meeting will be called in March 2024 to amend the By-laws with regard to changing the date of the Chapter's year end, brining into line financial accounting requirements and AGM dates.



Skeleton Coast Rally 2024

Well, if word has not reached you yet (highly unlikely), then let it be known that the Skeleton Coast Rally is taking place from April 25—27, 2024 in Swakopmund at The MTC Dome.

Preparations are full under way and a a great rally is planned. In brief :

- ⇒ April 24, Meet and Greet at Joe's Beerhouse, Windhoek (early registration)
- ⇒ April 25, travel to Swakomund, check in and join the party at The Dome as from 15:00 when registration continues and bar/vendors open.
- ⇒ April 25, 16:00 the Harley Derby in aid of Southern Cross Fund—you could be lucky
- ⇒ April 25, party and dance till late night
- ⇒ April 26, Leisure day (vrye tydsbestuur)

and revel in the activities offered along the Skeleton Coast. Check out the special deals organized with service providers such a Tandem Parachute Jumping, Catamaran excursions, Desert Tours and much more

- April 26, join HOG Namibia for Tour de Skeleton Coast, where HOG members will take you to places of interest along the Coast, with a few specials along the way
- April 26, bar/vendors open stalls and party commences, featuring Blikweg as live attraction.
- ⇒ April 26, auction in aid of charity
- April 27, Thunderparade and Outride briefing at 09:00 with kick-stands up at 09:30

- April 27, Thunderparade through Swakopmund and Outride along the coast to Walvisbay, where we turn around at the circle and head back to Swakopmund. Riders great opportunity for oncoming bikes on Outride. Pull off at Erik's Cove for mid-morning refreshments and eventually make own way back to Swakopmund
- ⇒ April 27, bar/vendors open at 15:00 at The Dome
- ⇒ April 27, Bikes for concourse sign in at 15:00—judging commences at 16:00
- ⇒ April 27, Harley games start at 16:00 (still negotiating with a Red Bull Stunt Rider as addon or alternative)
- ⇒ April 27, Music to commence at 16:00, we say our Thank-you's, hand over charity proceeds and slowly but surely make our way back to bed for the inevitable journey back home

- ⇒ The Skeleton Coast Rally 2024 at The MTC Dome is open for registration to <u>all Harley Owners and their Pillions.</u>

on November 11, 2023, Armistices Day. The MOTH, with the support of the HAMC and




The Gypsy Camp is the first of many activities planned for the 2024 calendar. The Gypsy Camp is quite novel, but it promises to be fun.
